Santas Grotto: Advanced Bookings have been extended to Thursday 5th December.

Book your slot to avoid queues/disappointment on the night. For every advanced booking, your child will receive a letter pack prior to the evening for children to write their letter to Santa. On the night each child will receive a selection box and a certificate from Santa.

After School Sports Clubs: Unfortunately, due to rising costs, we will have to start charging parents/carers for children to attend the after school sports clubs as school can no longer cover the full costs for external coaches. The subsidised cost will be £10 for each half term starting in January. We have tried to keep the costs as low as possible, this equates to less than £2 per session. The clubs affected are Football skills on Mondays & Multis-Sports on Tuesday & Wednesdays.

UNICEF: We have recently developed a UNICEF suggestion box designed by the children linked to the Rights of the Child. They have sorted the suggestions into two piles and shared the reasonable suggestions with Mrs Statham this week. SchoolGrid activation emails have been sent. Many thanks to everyone who has activated their account and logged in for the first time. If you haven't received an email, please contact the school office.

Once you activate your account and log in, it is important that you add any allergen information for your child.

If you are using SchoolGrid on a mobile phone, you can 'add to home page' to create a shortcut for ease of access.

A reminder that this system goes live on 2nd December. You can place orders now for week commencing 2nd December until we close for Christmas. You will see that the system shows 'No ordering - school closed' next week. School is not closed! This is simply to prevent orders before the system is launched in school.

Don't forget that the deadline is 4th December for ordering a Christmas dinner for Christmas dinner day (Fri 13th December). This allows the kitchen to place orders accordingly.

This system allows you to swap between school dinners and packed lunches. If you do not place an order by the daily cut off, it is expected that you have provided your child with a packed lunch from home. For this reason, we recommend that you register for SchoolGrid even if your child regularly brings a packed lunch to school as it will give you the flexibility to order a school dinner on any given day if you wish to do so.

E-Safety – we have recently installed a brand new Monitoring and Filtering system in school on every device. 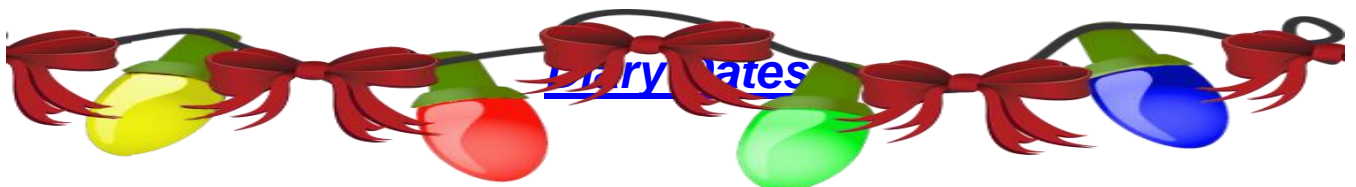
