New First Aid Arrangements: As per the letter which went out on Monday – any red wrist bands need to be left on for 48hrs as head injury symptoms can be identified during this critical 48 hr period. They are waterproof and can be slept in. It allows staff to recognise any important head injury symptoms the next days as well in school

Water Safety

Please make sure that children are kept safe around water, open water, rivers, lakes and reservoirs. Unfortunately, there have been several deaths of children and young teenagers in the past week during the hot weather period. The cold water shock can be incredibly dangerous – the difference between hot body temperatures and cold water temperatures. Children can easily get into difficulty

WHAT THE NEW RULES MEAN FOR ME

I'm a single parent of one child and we want to go on holiday for a week

Your holiday will not be authorised and you must talk to the school before you book anything.

Because your child will miss 5 school days you will be given a penalty notice fine.

The fine is £160 but if you pay it within 21 days it will be reduced to £80

IRREGULAR ATTENDANCE

10 IN 10

If your child is absent for 10 or more sessions in 10 weeks and their absences are unauthorised, the school will consider prosecution

1 day = 2 sessions

No discount for early payment



THIRD TIME

A penalty notice fine will not be given.

Instead your case will be taken to court.

A magistrate can fine each parent £2,500 for each child.

1 parent & 4 children = £10,000

2 parents & 4 children = £20,000
