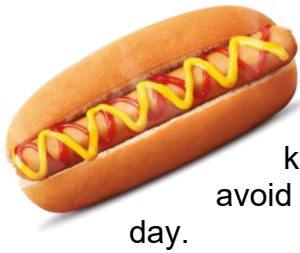

## Reminders

**Payments:** Please ensure that all dinner money payments and Tiger Club Fees are up-to date.

**Mobile Phones:** Reminder for Year 6 that all mobile phones must only be brought onto school premises pupil if a parent has signed a mobile phone contract. This applies to year 6 only.

**Reminder that pupils should not be wearing smart watches or any watches with a camera or any other message reading device.**

**Water Bottles:** From September each class will have individual holders in the classrooms. The maximum diameter of the holders is 9cm. Water bottles will need to be straight and not tapered, plastic and not metal.

**Side gate at Reception class:** This can only be opened by staff. Please ensure no parents are opening this gate via the hook and bolt. This is a safety and safeguarding issue. Thank you

### Water Safety

Please make sure that children are kept safe around water, open water, rivers, lakes and reservoirs. Unfortunately, there have been several deaths of children and young teenagers in the recent weeks during the hot weather period. The cold water shock can be incredibly dangerous – the difference between hot body temperatures and cold water temperatures. Children can easily get into difficulty

**Summer School Uniform:** Boys can wear tailored shorts – Girls can wear blue or yellow gingham dresses, skirts or tailored shorts. Girls can wear cycling shorts underneath their skirts or dresses if they wish.

**No Makeup:** Please remember that no pupils should be wearing makeup in school

**PE Kits:** Children should have either a plain **Navy Blue or Black tracksuit bottoms or shorts, (girls can wear cycling shorts), and a plain WHITE t-shirt**

**Reception and KS1 playground:** Please can we ensure that all children, including younger siblings stay away from all playground equipment and activities which are set up for children's learning, during drop off and collection. Many thanks



**Summer weather: HOT WEATHER: We are likely to get another heatwave!!** Please ensure hats and suncream are provided  
We will let you know re any adaptation to uniforms etc nearer the time.

**Safeguarding:** Please remember that WhatsApp minimum age is now 13 yrs of age. No Primary age children should be on it at all. As parents please always be aware of what screen and online activity your child is taking part in.

**Web Safe:** please ensure our children are safe online at all times!

**Reading:** Children should be reading at home 2 or 3 times a week and each time this should be recorded in their Reading Record Book.

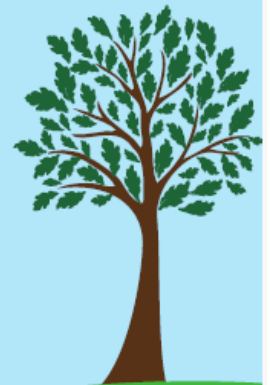

## WHAT THE NEW RULES MEAN FOR ME

1

**I'm a single parent of one child and we want to go on holiday for a week**

Your holiday will not be authorised and you must talk to the school before you book anything.

Because your child will miss 5 school days you will be given a penalty notice fine.

The fine is £160 but if you pay it within 21 days it will be reduced to £80

**IRREGULAR ATTENDANCE**

10 IN 10

If your child is absent for 10 or more sessions in 10 weeks and their absences are unauthorised, the school will consider prosecution

1 day = 2 sessions

**THIRD TIME**

A penalty notice fine will not be given.

Instead your case will be taken to court.

A magistrate can fine each parent £2,500 for each child.

**1 parent & 4 children = £10,000**

**2 parents & 4 children = £20,000**
