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Dear Parents/ Guardians,

Attached to your child's report are their SATs scores for the end of KS2 assessments taken back in May.

Below is an explanation of what the scaled scores mean:

The scaled score ranges from **80 to 120**:

- **100** is the **expected standard** for pupils at the end of Key Stage 2.
- A score of **100 or above** means your child has met the expected standard.
- A score of **Below 100** means your child has not yet met the expected standard and may need further support as they continue into secondary school.
- A score of **110 or above** indicates that your child is working at a **higher standard**.

You will receive scaled scores for:

- Reading
- Mathematics
- Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling (GPS)

Writing is **not assessed by a test**. Instead, I assess their writing throughout the year (along with moderators) against national standards. This assessment will be reported as one of the following:

- Working Towards the Expected Standard
- Working at the Expected Standard
- Working at Greater Depth within the Expected Standard
- Pre Key – Stage standard = an element of the child's work is not working at KS2 standard.

It is important to remember that SATs provide only a snapshot of your child's learning at the end of primary school. They do not measure creativity, resilience, kindness, sporting ability, artistic talent, or the many other qualities that children have. We are incredibly proud of the whole class.
