

Maths

In maths, we will look at the unit '**Place Value within 10 and then within 20**' In this unit the children will:

- Sort objects and count objects
- Represent objects
- Count forwards and backwards
- Count one more and one less
- One to one correspondence
- Compare objects and numbers
- Introduce < > = symbols
- Order objects and numbers
- Ordinal numbers
- The number line

We will also look at the next unit called '**Addition and Subtraction within 10**' In this unit the children will:

- Learn about the Whole-Part model
- Write number sentences
- Fact families
- Bonds to 10 and Number bonds within 10
- Add together and Add more
- Addition problems
- 8 fact families
- Take away/cross out
- Subtract on a number line

Computing

The unit is called 'Online Safety' The children will cover:

- Using the internet safely
- Online emotions

English

In English, we will spend Autumn 1 looking at composing our own simple sentences using **Colourful Semantics**.

This means starting with the **Who?** and then adding the **What doing?**

For example: The boy is brushing his teeth. The monkey is eating a banana.

We practise saying our sentence aloud.

We count how many words are in our sentence.

We remember our finger spaces.

We remember to use our segmenting for spelling.

We use full stops and capital letters.

We write on the line.

We form our letters correctly.

As well as composing our own sentences we will focus on some **dictated sentences** read by an adult.
