ASDA Bag Packing

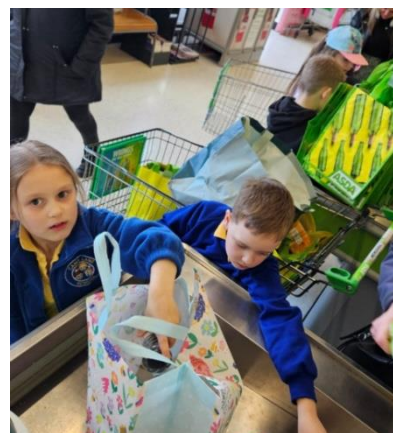
We raised an amazing £496.13
