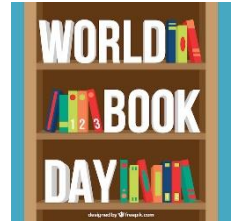

The next FCL event will be an Easter Bunny Hop Sponsored Day – as this was so successful last time we did it, we want to do it again.

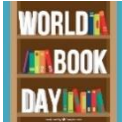
