Rewards

Consequences:

We have a system of yellow cards and red cards. We have a choice to follow the school rules or not. If you make the wrong choice you have to follow the school consequences

1. 1st Verbal warning
2. 2nd Verbal warning and yellow card on the table
3. Yellow Card in Green Chart
4. Red Card in the Green Chart
5. Going on Report
6. Suspension

If you get a yellow card, you will miss 5 mins of your playtime.
If you get a red card, you miss the whole playtime on a Friday with the Headteacher. A red card text message also gets sent home to parents
