

Maths

In maths, we will look at the unit 'Place Value within 10' In this unit the children will:

- Sort objects and count objects
- Represent objects
- Count forwards and backwards
- Count one more and one less
- One to one correspondence
- Compare objects and numbers
- Introduce < > = symbols
- Order objects and numbers
- Ordinal numbers
- The number line

We will also look at the next unit called 'Addition and Subtraction within 10' In this unit the children will:

- Learn about the Whole-Part model
- Write number sentences
- Fact families
- Bonds to 10 and Number bonds within 10
- Add together and Add more
- Addition problems
- 8 fact families
- Take away/cross out
- Subtract on a number line

PHSE/RSE

The unit is called 'Family and relationships'



Computing

The unit is called 'Online Safety' The children will cover:

- Using the internet safely
- Online emotions
- Always be kind and considerate
- Posting and sharing online

Music

The unit is called 'Keeping the pulse' They will explore a pulse and look at sound patterns.

Geography

Our unit is called 'What is it like here?'. In this unit they will cover:

- Where in the world we are?
- What can we see in our classroom?
- What can we find in our school grounds?
- Where are the different places in our school?
- How do we feel about our playground? Can we make it better?

Science

Our unit is called 'All about me'

The children will learn:

- About the human body
- Label parts of the body
- Look in more depth at our 5 senses, which are sight, hearing, taste, touch and smell

Our unit is called 'Drawing: Exploring line and shape'.

The unit covers:

RE

In RE we will be looking at the question 'What does it mean to belong to a faith community?'

English

In English, the children will be focusing on these books:

What makes me a me?

- We will be writing simple sentences using a capital letter, full stop and finger spaces to write all about ourself. We will introduce the use of 'and' to join two sentences together.

Dogger

- We will predict parts of the story, look at adjectives to describe Dogger and their own teddy. They will create a lost teddy poster, write sentences about things they do with their teddy and will sequence the story in chronological order.

Is there a dog in this book?

- We will continue to write simple sentences about the three cats and the dog in the book. They will then create a poster of how to look after a dog using commands like wash it, feed it etc.
