What does Tax-Free Childcare mean for me?

Tax-Free Childcare is a UK wide offer. [Eligible working parents](#) with children 11 or under can get up to £2,000 per child, per year, towards their childcare costs (or up to £4,000 for disabled children 16 or under).

Parents using the scheme open an online childcare account which they use to pay you directly for childcare. Payments work just as they do through an online bank account. Each payment is accompanied by a reference number for each child so you can identify their payments.

You will only be able to receive Tax-Free Childcare payments from your customers if you've [signed up](#) to Tax-Free Childcare.

Tax-Free Childcare is replacing childcare vouchers. Signing up to Tax-Free Childcare does not affect any payments you receive through childcare voucher schemes.
