Mathematics
Fractions

use common multiples to express fractions in the same denomination •
Compare and order fractions, including fractions >1

- Add and subtract fractions with different denominators and mixed numbers, using the concept of equivalent fractions

Multiply simple pairs of proper fractions,
Divide proper fractions by whole numbers
Associate a fraction with division and calculate decimal fraction equivalents for a simple fraction.

Science

- Recognize that light appears to travel in straight lines
- Explain that objects are seen because they give out or reflect light into the eye
 - Explain that we see things because light travels from light sources to our eyes or from light sources to objects and then to our eyes
- Use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain why shadows have the same shape as the objects that cast them.
