Dear Parent/Carers,

RE: How to help your child with their times table at home

Times tables is a priority in our school this year! It is expected that all children in England recall and use multiplication and division facts for all their tables up to 12x12 by the end of Year 4. Helping to learn their times tables starts from the beginning in Reception where they count in sequence and find patterns in numbers. We start chanting our times tables from Year 1 upwards. Chanting is where you pick a times table and say the times table together. For example, 1 ten is 10, 2 tens are 20, 3 10s are 30. First, we start chanting in order. Then, we mix the order of chanting. Your child should have come today with a times table booklet, which contains ideas and activities to help support your child with their times tables. We have added links to websites and examples of board games you can purchase or play. Your child will have been told by their teacher, which times tables they are currently working on. If they are unsure, please ask.
