

Maths

In maths, we will look at the unit 'Addition and Subtraction'

In this unit the children will:

- Learn about the Whole-Part model
- Write number sentences
- Fact families
- Bonds to 10
- Number bonds within 10
- Add together
- Add more
- Addition problems
- 8 fact families
- Take away/cross out
- Subtract on a number line

We will also look at the next unit called 'Geometry: shape'

In this unit the children will:

- Recognise and name 2D shapes
- Sort 2D shapes
- Recognise and name 3D shapes
- Sort 3D shapes
- Create repeating patterns and continue repeating patterns

RE

- In RE we will be looking at the question
- 'Why does Christmas matter to Christians?'
