Social activities for children/young people with Special Education Needs and/or Disabilities (SEND), for Primary and Secondary aged children. A variety of activities that are inclusive for a broad range of disabilities and needs. Depending on the venue size and capacity, we aim to keep the activities to smaller group sizes to ensure that it is manageable for our children of whom many have sensory processing difficulties. All of our activities will be exclusively booked so that our families feel as comfortable as possible. Bee Inclusive acts as the booking agent for the activities and generally uses external providers. Due to the varying complexities of the children/young people's needs, at all our activities a parent/carer must stay to supervise their child/young person. This supports peer-peer support between parents/carers and helps promote a network of support and friendship for children/young people. To meet the needs of the children/young people and to ensure a quality accessible offer, our activities are located in a variety of locations across Bury and the surrounding area.

It is important to note that Bee Inclusive is a voluntary led community interest company. We do not have a base level of paid staff in place to deliver, plan or administer the HAF offer. Therefore our current skeleton staff levels will be increased to facilitate this, which is reflected in the bid administration cost that will be required to facilitate the offer.

Parent/carers can support children on the trampolines if their needs require it, and this builds on the offer of supporting family fun. Children can freely move between the soft play area, "That Fun Place" and the trampolining area, so they have a choice of activity. This is a 2 hour activity. Children make a pizza themselves with 'Dough So Good' pizza company. They then participate in a craft session painting pottery whilst they wait for their pizza to be cooked and then eat their pizza's together. Bee Inclusive will supply the pots and paint. This has historically been a very popular session due to its accessibility for wheelchair users and those with complex care needs. Tables are 'rise and fall', allowing wheelchair users to be involved fully. Painting is an activity that with help, most of our families with complex needs can join in with and enjoy together. The activity allows children/young people to learn cookery and craft skills. This is an exclusive booking for children/young people with SEND only.

Bury Defence Academy

We are mainly a martial arts and boxing club offering a range of 7 combat sports to young people. We have around 450 weekly service users and most of them are young people aged under 18. We run regular sports competitions and also have onsite youth mentors who can provide close support to young people with behavioural problems. We work with various schools and also have 2 classrooms that we use for a weekend Arabic school and other educational activities.

We will run a mix of indoor multi sports activities combined with various activities outdoors. Indoors, we will be delivering various sports-based activities including Boxing (none contact), Football, Dodgeball, Softball, Tug of War, Circuit Training and more. We also have 2 classrooms that will be used for Arts and Craft, Board Games and watching age-appropriate videos.

We will also be using our minibus to take as many young people outdoors as possible. This will be for visits and play in various local parks (Burry Country Park, Heaton Park, Mayfield Park and others). We have booked a group trip to the Greater Manchester Fire and Rescue Service and will be arranging a group trip.

We will provide play camps will be based in our children's centre based in Prestwich. These will involve the following activities;

- Sports and physical exercise sessions including an intergenerational sports event with older people living as residents at Heathlands Village.
- Arts, crafts, and baking including as focus on nutrition and healthy eating.
- A nature walk, gardening, tending our sensory garden with herbs.

Accessible, free transport will be provided to enable children and young people to attend and get home. We will offer 8 children from Bury a place at our play camps. The children will be aged 4-15 years old. Children will undertake health and fitness activities for at least one hour a day. The activities will include cycling proficiency skills, sports day, physical games, and lots of outside play. The sessions will be offered to children in Bury living with complex disabilities and social care needs. The sessions will take place in our Children's Centre which is a bright modern building with specialist play equipment and adaptations for disabled children as well as toys and books. There is safe, secure space for outdoor play. The majority of the children who will attend the groups will have a limited social life due to their health conditions. They may require one to one support in a calm and well-staffed environment. We know from talking to children themselves and their families that they love coming to the centre and value the chance to play with friends their own age and try new experiences. The cohort of disabled children currently supported are maturing and require highly complex support packages to allow them to participate in Jewish cultural/social life.

Our staff ratios (sometimes two to one) have increased so we can remain accessible. There is no provision locally that caters for Jewish children with complex disabilities from across the spectrum of religious observance. Our project is open to all Jewish children in the community, whether religious or not. Our staff are trained and experienced at providing specialist care to this cohort of children. All staff undergo an enhanced DBS check and regular training. We will

undertake cooking with the children and encourage children to participate in meal preparation. Many of the activities we will offer are focused on building children's confidence and social skills as many struggle to socialise. We will offer exercises and activities that build up children's self-esteem and will provide plenty of praise and feedback and have as much fun as possible.
