Dear Parent/Carer

Reception and Year 1 will be going on a trip to Blackpool Zoo on **Monday 29th June 2026**. They will visit lots of animals and learn facts about a range of animals from where they live to what they eat. As well as walking around the zoo we will be having an educational workshop called animal groups led by a leader at the zoo. In addition to that each child will get to hand feed the Lorikeets.

School uniform and trainers will be required. Suncream must be put on your child before they arrive at school. All children must have a sun hat. Sunglasses are optional.

The coach will be leaving at 9am, so please can children come to school for 8:45am that day so we can register and use the toilet etc in time for a prompt leave. Any children who are late unfortunately will miss going on the trip. We are expected back at school for the usual time of 3:15pm. If for any reason we are stuck in traffic, we will update you.

The cost of the trip is **£28** - this is a voluntary contribution however without enough voluntary contributions we may not be able to run the trip and it may have to be cancelled. You can pay for the trip in instalments over the next 10 weeks. **All payments must be received by Monday the 1st of June 2026.**

If you are unable to make the contribution then please let the office know as soon as possible

Your child will need a packed lunch, in a named plastic carrier bag, ensuring every item is disposable (including their drink). Please provide multiple drinks in case the weather is warm. If your child is entitled to free school meals, the school can provide one at your request. You will need to pre-order a sandwich on SchoolGrid by **1/6/26**.

Please give consent for this trip and make any voluntary contributions on ARBOR - all parents have been sent a letter regarding access to this system, but please get in touch with the office, if you have difficulties.
