Welcome to the Summer Term

I hope you have all had a great Easter break, and your child is looking forward to their final term in Year 1.

We have so many new topics to cover this term.

In art, we are looking at 3D structures, using paper. They will learn how to roll, shape and fold paper to create a variety of 3D structures. We will work collaboratively to design and build a large 3D spider, using newspaper.

In DT, we will be designing and making our own puppets in 'Textiles.' As well as designing and making a pencil potholder in 'Structures.'

In English, we will look at a book called 'The Night Pirates.' This engages all children to be creative in their writing where they take on a role as a pirate, as well as the little boy in the story. They also create their own pirate to join the team. We also hold a pirate day where they come in dress as a pirate if you would like to start looking for a pirate costume. A letter will follow with more information.

We look forward to our trip along with Reception to Blackpool Zoo, where we can learn lots about animals and their habitats. We get to feed the Lorikeets. Hopefully, we should have lovely weather!

In June, your child will sit the Government Phonics Screening Check. Please keep practising those sounds and words with your child daily. Do not forget they can go online (Phonics Play) which is a much more interactive way. For the parents who have asked for homework I will be sending each week a practice paper to go over with your child. On Tapestry I will explain how you complete this with your child.

Later in this term, we will have our Sports Day, where you can come and watch. In PE, the coach will prepare the children with lots of mini team games and events.

Keep checking Tapestry as well as our class page for updates about your child's learning. We have thoroughly enjoyed watching your child grow both socially and academically.
