In this unit the children will:

- Compare length and height
- Measure using cm
- Measure using m

We will also look at the next unit called '**Mass and Volume**'

In this unit the children will:

- Use the words heavier and lighter
- Measure and compare mass
- Use the words full and empty
- Compare volume
- Measure and compare capacity

History

In this unit they will cover:

- How can you tell these toys are old?
- What were our grandparents' toys like? How do we know?

English
