In maths, we will look at the unit '**Multiplication and Division**'

In this unit the children will:

- Count in 2s, 10s and 5s
- Recognise equal groups
- Add equal groups
- Make arrays and doubles
- Make equal groups by sharing
- Make equal groups by grouping

We will also look at the next unit called '**Fractions**'

In this unit the children will:

- Recognise and find half of a shape or object
- Recognise and find a quarter of a shape or object
- Recognise and find half of a quantity
- Recognise and find a quarter of a quantity

We will also look at the next unit called '**Position and Direction**'

- Describe turns
