

Sport Premium 2022-2023



At Cams Lane, we are fully committed to promoting sports and healthy lifestyles, ensuring that each and every child is able to access a varied range of sporting activities, both in school time, lunchtimes and after school.

What is the Sports Premium?

The government has made available funding to provide primary school sports. The funding goes directly into school budgets to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE (not including covering teachers PPA time).

For this academic year **we have approx. £17,000** to spend on improving the PE, Sport and Games provision which is made in two payments through the year.

Purpose of the funding

The money is being given to schools to help them to make sustainable improvements to the provision of PE sessions and sport enrichment. Schools are then given the choice on what to spend it on.

How are we spending our money?

We have allocated the money as follows:
